What is in the kit? These kits are made of the following materials:

- Grow materials: Potting Mix / Soil / Compost; Berry Starts (let's talk about the varieties you'd like!)
- Build materials: Protective netting

What can you grow with this kit?

- **Berries**: raspberries, salmon berries, currants, blueberries, and more! (or less)

Requirements if you take this kit:

- Tools and Equipment: Hand trowel and Hose or Bucket for watering
