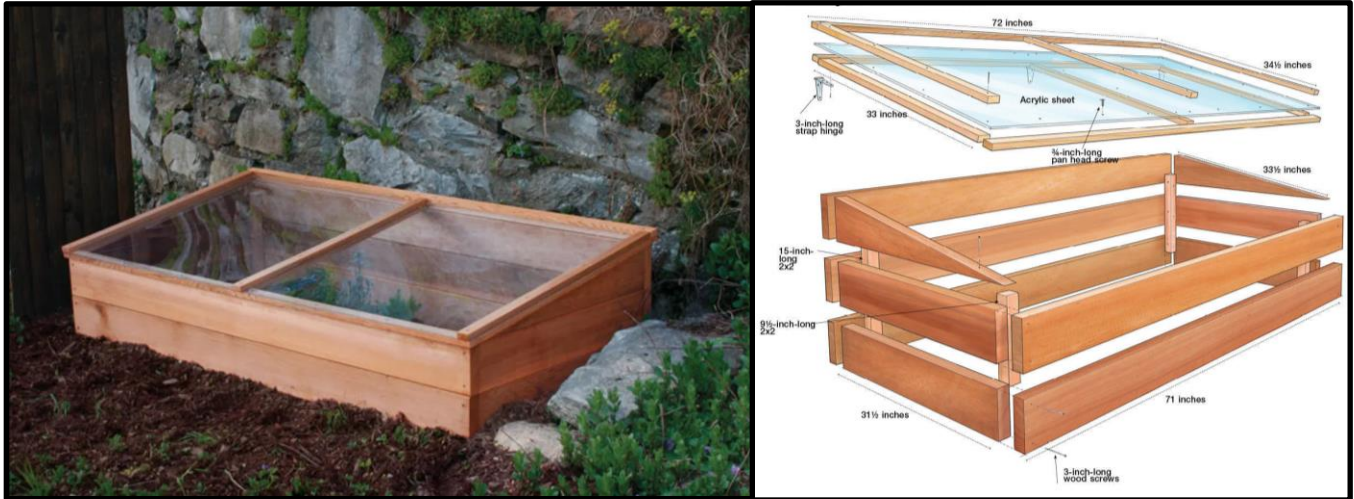


Alaska Resilience Farms - Build Your Own Cold Frame



What is in the kit? These kits are made of the following materials:

- Build materials: Lumber (1x1's, 2x1's, and 2x4's); Acrylic sheet; Wood screws
- Grow materials: Potting Mix / Soil / Compost; Seeds or Plant Starts

What can you grow with this kit?

- **Herbs** (basil, parsley, dill, etc.) **Leafy Greens** (lettuce, kale, etc.) & **Plant Starts** (like a mini nursery!)

Requirements if you take this kit:

- Tools and Equipment: Power Drill with standard Phillips bit or Phillips Screwdriver, 2 Clamps
- Reporting: We will need 2 photos or videos from you. These will be entered into the Alaska Resilience Garden Photo Contest and are due by June 30th, 2023! (Date flexible for subsistence activities)
 - 1) Photo/Video of your kit during or after assembly
 - 2) Photo/Video of your kit with something starting to grow in it
